New Rule Requires the RRT Credential for Initial Licensure by 2015—Not Exactly!

Recently the Board adopted a new rule on requiring the Registered Respiratory Therapist (RRT) examination for initial licensure. This came after two years of discussions with various groups of licensees and other interested parties. In April 2013, the Board adopted the rule, titled rule 4761-5-01: **Waiver of licensing requirements pursuant to division (B) of section 4761.04 of the Revised Code**. Since the adoption of this rule, the Board has received numerous inquiries about the rule's intent or impact, many based on inaccurate information.

It's common to discuss issues of mutual interest with your colleagues, and many times this is the first source of new work-related information. These discussions are normally very insightful. It's always interesting to hear a variety of opinions on a new topic. However, as professionals we can't rely on casual discussions as our sole source of information on such an important topic. It's only human nature to overlook some aspects of an issue and perhaps overstate another. This may result in an incomplete, or in some cases, a completely inaccurate understanding of the facts.

Some callers have been lead to believe their employer is requiring employees to become an RRT, because the new rule will mandate it. Others report that they have heard the new rule will eliminate their license in 2015, because they are not an RRT. Neither of these is true.

The Board has prepared a Frequently Asked Questions sheet addressing the new rule. It's posted on the Board's website: www.respiratorycare.ohio.gov. I would recommend you take a look at this document. It's as a good source of valid information regarding the new rule. Here are a few other facts about the rule:

- 1: Any person that has been issued a license in the state of Ohio prior to January 1, 2015, can continue to practice respiratory care in the state of Ohio without interruption. **Revised OAC Rule 4761-5-01 does not have any impact on persons already licensed in the state of Ohio before January 1, 2015.**
- 2: Employers may have independent hiring standards that meet or exceed the minimum licensure standards. If an employer requires an RRT credential for employment, the requirement is not based on the new rule.
- 3: An applicant issued a new license in another state after January 1, 2015 must hold the RRT credential to be eligible for licensure in the State of Ohio. Applicants issued a license in another state prior to January 1, 2015 will be eligible for Ohio licensure if the out-of-state license was issued based on the CRT or RRT credential.
- 4: A new graduate seeking an initial license after January 1, 2015 must successfully complete the RRT examination consisting of both the written and clinical simulation portions to be eligible for licensure in Ohio.

The new rule seeks to create parity between Ohio and other states by recognizing persons licensed prior to January 1, 2015, regardless of their basis for licensure.

2014 Renewal—Update and Changes

2014 Renewal packets will be mailed to all active respiratory care license and limited permit holders and all active home medical equipment (HME) facilities (licensed or registered) on or about March 15, 2014. Similar to the renewal process in 2012, the Board is encouraging respiratory care licensees and HME providers to use the online renewal system to complete application submission. Online renewal is a fast and easy method to meet your renewal requirements. An optional paper form will be available for persons and businesses requesting the form. The form and requested information is similar to the 2012 renewal, but some things have changed. The following information should help prepare you for renewal:

Continuing Education Reporting Changes:

New changes to the online continuing education reporting format should make respiratory care license renewal easier. The Board has eliminated the individual course reporting requirement for 2014. This means licensed respiratory therapists and some limited permit holders (L2 types) will be required to affirm compliance with the biennial continuing education requirements, but reporting each course taken will not be required. Instead, the Board will rely upon post-renewal audits. This means licensees must maintain documentation of compliance in accordance with rule 4761-9-02 (F) of the Administrative Code.

Minimum Data Set Questions:

The renewal form for licensed respiratory care professionals will require licensees to answer a series of questions designed to collect workforce data. The Ohio Respiratory Care Board is participating in a statewide effort to collect comprehensive workforce data for licensed health care professionals. In February 2012, Governor Kasich created the Office of Workforce Transformation (OWT) to coordinate and align workforce policies, programs and resources across the state. The Governor's Office of Health Transformation (OHT) is also involved by coordinating health sector workforce activities. In collaboration with the Ohio Department of Health (ODH), the Board has developed survey questions that will align with nationally recognized Minimum Data Set requirements for all primary care disciplines. These data will add elements to Ohio's minimum data set that are required for designation of federal Health Professional Shortage Areas, and aid in the development of an advanced primary care workforce-forecasting model to assist in planning for health professions education programs, recruitment, and retention strategies.

HME providers:

HME facilities hold either a license or a certificate of registration. HME renewal can be completed online, but some documentation must be mailed to the Board in advance of completing the online process. The following documentation should be obtained and mailed in advance:

HME Licensees-

1. Copy of liability insurance certificate showing professional and product liability coverage in the amount of 3 million dollars aggregate/1 million dollars per occurrence minimum.

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2. Copy of continuing education plan meeting the requirements of rule 4761:1-13-01 of the Administrative Code.

How to improve your chances for successful license renewal:

- (1) Update your mailing address if you have moved. The Board re-mails approximately 400 renewal applications each renewal due to moving. OAC rule 4761-10-03 requires license and permit holders to update address, employment information, or academic standing changes within 60 days.
- (2) Read the instructions. The Board office addresses a very large number of inquiries during renewal that are clearly explained in the instructions.
- (3) Complete all continuing education requirements prior to completing the renewal form. Also, review the continuing education requirements under OAC 4761-9-02. Additionally, continuing education must come from an approved source, noted under OAC 4761-9-05 (See below). Continuing education must comply with these rules or it will be rejected.

HME Certificate of Registration Holders:

1. An updated Certificate of Accreditation form. This form documents current accreditation by a recognized accrediting organization. The form is available on the Board's website under forms and applications.

Continuing Education Requirements

All laws and rules governing respiratory care and home medical equipment licensure are available on the Board's website: www.respiratorycare.ohio.gov.

Respiratory Care Renewal:

First, licensees and affected limited permit holders should read OAC 4761-9-05. This rule identifies the acceptable sources for continuing education. During renewal, the Board receives continuing education from hundreds of different sources, but not all are accepted. The following is a summary of this rule:

The Board will accept continuing education from any of the following combined sources:

1. Relevant college credit from an accredited institution.
2. Continuing education offered by an accredited respiratory care educational program.
3. Advanced life support programs or instructor for life support programs. Instructors must provide documentation or hours completed.
4. Recertification of advanced life support programs. Again, instructors must provide documentation of hours completed.
5. Relevant continuing education approved for contact hours by a professional organization or association. Examples include the AARC, OSRC, AMA, OSMA, ANA, ONA, OTS, ACCP, AHA, ALA, OLA, and AACCN. These organizations are listed completely in the rule.

The following is a summary of OAC 4761-9-02:

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Continuing Education Requirements Continued—from Page 3

Respiratory Care Professionals:

- (1) Shall complete twenty contact hours of relevant RCCE every two years. The twenty hours will include:
 - (a) One (1) contact hour of RCCE on Ohio respiratory care law or professional ethics as set forth in rule 4761-9-04 of the Administrative Code.
 - (b) At least fifteen (15) contact hours must include content relating to the provision of clinical respiratory care as defined under section 4761.01 of the Revised Code.
 - (c) Up to four (4) contact hours may include indirectly related content, including, but not limited to, activities relevant to specialized aspects of respiratory care, such as education, supervision, management, health care cost containment, cost management, health quality standards, disease prevention, health promotion, or abuse reporting.

Employment-based Limited Permit Holders must complete:

- (2) Shall complete ten (10) contact hours of relevant RCCE every year. The ten hours will include:
 - (a) One (1) contact hour of RCCE on Ohio respiratory care law or professional ethics as set forth in rule 4761-9-04 of the Administrative Code.
 - (b) At least seven (7) contact hours must include content relating to the provision of clinical respiratory care as defined under section 4761.01 of the Revised Code.
 - (c) Up to two (2) contact hours may include indirectly related content, including, but not limited to activities relevant to specialized aspects of respiratory care, such as education, supervision, management, health care cost containment, cost management, health quality standards, disease prevention, health promotion, or abuse reporting.

Waiver provisions:

A first time license holder in the state of Ohio who has been licensed for more than six months, but less than one year from the license expiration date must complete at least ten contact hours of continuing education, including one contact hour on Ohio respiratory care law or professional ethics. First time license holders who have held a license for less than six months from the biennial license expiration date will not be required to complete the RCCE requirements for the current term of collection, but will have to complete the RCCE requirements for the next biennial renewal period.

A request to waive the RCCE requirements may also be filed and a waiver granted for either of the following:

- (a) The applicant has been absent from Ohio for more than one half of the term of collection for the authorization type held due to military service;
- (b) The applicant has been prevented from completing the RCCE requirement due to documented proof of a medical disability for more than one half of the term of collection for the authorization type held.

Here's some tips:

1. Unless a licensee meets a waiver under [OAC 4761-9-02](#) (G), the Board requires licensees to complete 20 contact hours of **recognized** continuing education (see [OAC 4761-9-05](#)) every renewal cycle. 15 contact hours must be directly related to the provision of clinical respiratory care, up to 4 contact hours can be indirectly related, and 1 contact hour must be an **approved** hour on professional/medical ethics or Ohio respiratory care regulation law review (see [OAC 4761-9-04](#)).
2. If a continuing education course is taken before the rule allows or before the licensee is actually licensed, it is not accepted by the Board.
3. Know what activities are not accepted (see [OAC 4761-9-03](#)). For example: Personal development activities not taken for the purpose of meeting RCCE requirements would not be recognized. This could include academic education taken for another profession degree, such as nursing.
4. A licensee is responsible for maintaining all documentation that supports compliance with OAC 4761-9. Documentation must be kept for two renewal cycles (four years for license holders).

Governor Kasich Announces Launch of Human Trafficking Awareness Campaign



On March 29, 2012, Governor Kasich signed Executive Order 2012-06K, creating the Ohio Human Trafficking Taskforce. The Taskforce was directed to identify and rescue victims, coordinate law enforcement systems to investigate and prosecute Human Trafficking crimes and to provide service and treatment to victims. On June 19, 2013, Governor Kasich announced that his administration would be launching a statewide Human Trafficking Awareness Campaign to combat Human Trafficking by educating the public on how to recognize and report crimes, as well as assist victims with services and treatment. The Ohio Respiratory Care Board and all other state regulatory Boards and Commissions have joined Governor Kasich's efforts to bring awareness to this awful crime.

The Human Trafficking Taskforce will work with the Ohio Human Trafficking Commission under the Ohio Attorney General Mike DeWine's office. Materials and information are available on the Governor's webpage: <http://humantrafficking.ohio.gov/>. This material is open-source to the public and we encourage our licensees—community groups, faith based groups, private sector folks—who want to join in the fight to look at the material there and post them in every corner of the state so we can start to identify people who need our help.

Human trafficking – the illegal trade of human beings for commercial sexual exploitation and forced labor – is one of the fastest growing criminal enterprises worldwide. Each year an estimated 1,078 Ohio children become victims of human trafficking and 3,016 more are at-risk for exploitation.



Board Honors Longest Serving Physician Member—Robert C. Cohn, M.D.

On June 19, 2013, the Ohio Respiratory Care Board honored Dr. Robert C. Cohn for his twelve years of service to the State of Ohio and the Ohio Respiratory Care Board. Dr. Cohn retired from the Board after serving four three-year terms. Dr. Cohn was first appointed to the Board by Governor Bob Taft on March 29, 2001. As a Pediatric Pulmonologist and prior Director of Pulmonary Services at two Ohio hospitals, Dr. Cohn displayed an extraordinary enthusiasm for the respiratory care profession. Dr. Cohn served on several Board Committees, but Chaired, almost exclusively during his term, the Scope of Practice Committee where his medical knowledge and experience was greatly needed. Dr. Cohn was awarded an AARC fellowship in 2007.
